



The Edle Design Show Room in Beijing, China was designed and completed via faxes and phone calls in four months.

The Generic Chairs, a series of thirty five variations of a standard form, were developed from the simple question: 'Why should a dining set have similar chair design'. Made from teak wood the prototypes were completed in furniture factory in China in one week.

The Wuhan Residential Project, was a collaboration with Singapore Polytechnic students to design a 34,000sqm residential development consisting of four hundred and twenty units.



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
